One particular advantage of early booking and payment is that we absorb smaller hikes and price increases. Dates and itineraries are valid for current year. Beyond current year, prices, and itineraries are indicative only.

All scheduled small group journeys typically include transfers, sightseeing with entrance fees, English speaking local guides and accommodation, meals. Meals included are indicated by **B/L/D** (**B** for breakfast, **L** for lunch, **D** for dinner). Trips to Bhutan include also include Bhutan Visa fees, royalties. Trips to Tibet include Tibet permit for the duration (Chinese visa required). Most internal flight costs also include airport taxes. Pre-departure information. Visa information kit (if applicable). Office administration and support. Itinerary research and design. Final document

*Visa for countries other than Bhutan. *Personal expenses such as telephone calls, laundry, beverages, bottled waters in restaurants, optional tips or gratuities to local staffs. *Some sightseeing spots or monuments may charge fees to allow you to enter with your camera or Camcorder. *At the time of printing this brochure, airport or departure taxes in Nepal was payable in cash by the passengers themselves at check-in *Any additional costs involved in changing an itinerary either due to your own choice or due to force majeure (acts of God, war, labor strikes, earthquake, flooding, etc.). Deposit and Payment Schedule

- ◆ A late booking fee up to \$200 may for late reservation on our small group journeys (not for private departures).

*Prices are quoted in US dollars and all payments must be made in US dollars or its equivalent.

*Reservation deposit is accepted by credit card but there may be additional fees to pay the remainder by Credit Card.

*Accepted forms of payments besides credit cards are Personal or Certified Checks, Drafts, Money Order, Wire Transfers and Traveler's checks.

Cancellations & Refunds

- ◆ 91 days prior departure, forfeiture of booking deposit (\$200 per person)
- ◆ 61-90 days prior to the departure \$400 per person or 25% of the total trip cost, whichever is higher.
- ◆ 45 days prior to departure: \$600 per person or 50 % of the Land Cost (whichever is higher).
- ◆ Between 44-31days prior to departure, 75 % or \$800 (whichever is higher)
- ◆ 30 days or less : no refund
- ◆ No partial refund will be granted on unused land portion once tour has begun for any reason whatsoever.

Wind Horse Holidays, Inc must normally make substantial payments to its suppliers (hotels, transportation companies, etc.) far in advance of the scheduled trip date. If a trip is canceled due to force majeure

(acts of God, war, labor strikes, earthquake, flooding, etc.), Wind Horse Holidays, Inc. will promptly refund the portion of the trip cost not already advanced to suppliers and use its best efforts to recover and refund the balance as promptly as possible. However, Wind Horse Holidays, Inc, does not guarantee recovery of any or all of the advance payments made, and our use of best efforts to recover these payments will not include the institution of any legal proceedings in foreign jurisdictions.

• Claims for refund of services not rendered must be accompanied by a statement from the Tour Manager/Guide or local Wind Horse Holidays representative certifying exactly the services not rendered.

• Voluntary non-usage of hotel accommodations, tour features and services are nonrefundable or exchangeable for other accommodations, tour features and services.

• Travel insurance, visa fee, and visa handling fee are nonrefundable.

• Since most airline tickets are discounted in Wind Horse Holidays tour packages, refund may be subject to penalty from supplier/airline and it may not be in full face value, and may require prepayment of processing fee to Wind Horse Holidays. Please allow 4-6 weeks to process refund, and longer for airline ticket refund.

Change Fee

For changes you make after the booking has been made, you will be charged a fee of \$50 plus actual fees imposed by the suppliers such as hotels, airlines etc.

Airline Clause

The airlines are not to be held responsible for any act, omission or event during the time passengers are not on board their planes or conveyance. The passage contract in use by the airlines concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the airlines and such purchasers of these tours and/or passenger. Such conveyance, etc. is subject to the laws of the countries involved. Airlines used vary in degree of safety and risk. Many air carriers have an unknown safety and maintenance record. Wind Horse is not liable for incidents involving airline safety, cancellations, service, risk, delays, etc., or incidents that result in injury or death as a result. Please read the conditions on the back of your airline tickets.

Air Reservations

Wind Horse will gladly arrange airfare for you to join any of our programs.

Please indicate your airfare needs on the reservation form. Please note that airfares are not guaranteed until purchased and ticketed. Should you decide to make your own arrangements, including mileage-based reservations, please supply Wind Horse with a copy of your air itinerary showing arrival and departure flights and times at least 2-3 weeks prior to departure.

Medical, Health & Physical Qualifications

It is vital that persons with medical problems make them known to us well before departure. The trip leader /Guides has the right to disqualify anyone at any time during the trip if he or she feels the trip member is physically or mentally incapable or if a trip member's continued participation will jeopardize the individual involved or the group. Refunds are not given under such circumstances.

Hospital facilities for serious problems are often unavailable and evacuation can be prolonged, difficult, and expensive. Wind Horse assumes no liability regarding provision of medical care.

Consult with your personal physician about your physical ability to complete the trip you are enrolled. Generally speaking, anyone in reasonably good health is able to travel in Asia. If you're not sure, check with your physician. Our mountain treks require much more physically demanding than our cultural tours. To ascertain your level of fitness (especially for treks) take the Harvard Step Test online at <http://www.brianmac.demon.co.uk/havard.htm>

After that, follow the common-sense precautions. While Wind Horse will take every precaution once you arrive at your destination to maintain hygienic and healthy practices, you need to take ultimate responsibility for your own health and well-being.

Immunizations

Although proof of various immunizations is not required for entry into Wind Horse's destination countries, we strongly recommend that you get all major vaccinations appropriate for the areas you will visit. For the most up-to-date information on recommended immunizations for each country/region, visit the US Centers for Disease Control website at www.cdc.gov

Your Public Health Department can often give you the best practical and current information on immunizations and prevention, and many can administer vaccinations. Keep in mind that some shots may be given simultaneously, but shots within a series (like TwinRix, the Hepatitis A & B combo vaccine) may be administered several weeks or even months apart. Allow at least eight weeks for the entire process. The following immunizations are typically recommended for travel to Asia, but be sure to check with your physician for the most current recommendations.

Hepatitis A & B – TwinRix vaccine covers Hep A & B together; Havrix is the vaccine for Hep A only. Typhoid – oral or injection. Tetanus-diphtheria – booster needed every ten years

Polio – booster as adult.

Pre-Trip Conditioning

The better shape you are in, the more you will enjoy your trip. While much of the travel is by vehicle, there is a considerable amount of walking in cities, villages, museums and monasteries. Consult your doctor if you have any questions about exercise. If you are going on a trek, we recommend regular aerobic exercise sessions during the weeks prior to your trip. If you supplement these workouts with long training walks during the weekends you'll be better prepared for your trip. Sustained aerobic exercise may involve cycling, swimming, running, dancing or any other activity which builds heart and lung capacity. Try to build increased activity into your daily life: walk up stairs whenever possible, and walk or bicycle to work. In addition to cardiovascular workouts, you may want to concentrate on strengthening quadriceps (THIGH) muscles, helping you prevent knee problems.

Responsibilities of trip members

Trip members have certain responsibilities to Wind Horse and to other trip members. Trip members are responsible for understanding the conditions implied in the Trip Itinerary and selecting a trip in consultation with Wind Horse that is appropriate to their interests and abilities, and for preparing for the trip by studying the Trip Itinerary and supplemental trip information sent by Wind Horse and other additional literatures available online or other sources and bringing the appropriate clothing and equipment. At the trip leader's discretion, a member may be asked to leave the trip if the leader feels that the person's further participation may be detrimental to the individual or to other trip members.

Itinerary & Price Changes

Published itineraries and hotels for all tours are subject to change. Prices listed in this brochure are subject to change. We do our best to avoid raising prices, but as we publish our prices a year or more in advance, we must reserve the right to add a surcharge or to modify or cancel a tour if we are faced with significant increased costs including (but not limited to) changes in airfares, fuel surcharges and currency fluctuations, over which we have no control. One of the advantages of early booking is that we absorb all the minor price changes.

Delays

The cost of delays is not included if any trip must be delayed due to bad weather, trail conditions, river levels, road conditions, transportation delays, government intervention, sickness or other contingency or which Wind Horse or its agents cannot make provision.

Baggage

Wind Horse assumes no liability for loss or damage to baggage in transit to and from a Wind Horse trip or while on a Wind Horse trip. We recommend purchasing the supplemental travel insurance package.

Accommodation Policies

If you prefer single accommodations, the single supplement fee/ single occupancy rate is payable. Single accommodations are not always available as some nights may be spent in yurts/gers, tents, lodges, guesthouses, aboard regularly-scheduled rail service or in private homes and are subject to the availability of rooms and/or camping space. Double accommodations may have twin beds or one double bed. On trains, cabin configurations differ by class of service and by train, with most cabins configured with upper/lower berths. We are happy to attempt to make a same gender roommate match for solo travelers who request it. Should no one be available with whom you can share, you will be assessed the single supplement fee/single occupancy rate at the time of invoicing. In the event of a last-minute cancellation or roommate incompatibility resulting in assignment of a single room, the single supplement fee/single occupancy rate will be assessed. Wind Horse reserves the right to alter hotels or accommodations by substituting with similar ones, if the reserved hotel becomes unavailable. Particularly in Tibet and Bhutan, hotels tend to be small and local regulations allow them to change or deny reserved rooms.

Visas and Passports

A valid passport with six months validity from the end of the tour is required for participation. Wind Horse will obtain Bhutan Visa, Tibet inner Permits, Permits to the restricted areas that are covered by your trip. All other visas must be processed by you. Nepal visa can be obtained upon arrival for a fee of approx \$30, which is waived if staying in the country for 3 nights or less. China and Indian visas cannot be obtained upon arrival and so you must process at home. Wind Horse cannot assume responsibility for any costs associated with a traveler's refused visa issuance or refused entry into a country due to incorrect or incomplete documentation. It is the traveler's responsibility to check visas and passports for accuracy prior to departure.
